COVID-19 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

In accordance with Health Orders imposed by the VIC Government to help control the spread of COVID-19 you will notice some differences in our club and some new rules that we ask you to follow. Our ability to operate depends on everyone doing their bit to follow these rules, so we ask you to please take a moment to review these new conditions of entry for our club.

Any persons entering our club agrees to comply with the following “Conditions of Entry”, which have been implemented in accordance with the current VIC Public Health Order relating to this premises for the purpose of keeping members and guests safe. It

It is a condition of entry to our club that all members and guests are vaccinated against COVID-19. Proof of vaccination will be required.

Please note that during the sanctioned training sessions, unvaccinated participants are permitted to access toilet facilities. However, once the ‘community sport’ session has ended, access to the clubrooms is only permitted to those who are fully vaccinated

In addition, all members and guests attending the premises shall:

- Sign in using either:
 - The Service Victoria QR app; or
 - An entry log, providing their name, phone number and time of entry
- Present evidence that they have:
 - received their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine; or
 - a medical exemption provided by an authorised medical practitioner
- Be refused entry if they:
 - Display any flu-like symptoms (sore throat, runny nose, persistent cough, shortness of breath, fever).
 - Are awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19, or reside with anyone who is awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19; or
 - Have failed to observe the government requirement to quarantine for 14 days.
- Be requested to leave should they display signs of illness after entry
- Comply with reasonable directions from COVID Marshals.

Failure to comply with any or all of these conditions may constitute an offence under the Public Health Order and the club flag officers, members of the committee reserve the right to remove from the premises any person not adhering to these conditions.
